How We Help

We are a local pharmacy that offers a higher level of care to all of our patients, such as proactive refill reminders and 24-hours-a-day, 7-days-a-week access to a pharmacist. By enrolling in the Therapy Management Program, you also have:

- Easy access to a nurse or pharmacist knowledgeable about your specialty medication therapy, including your needs and goals of therapy.
- Help in learning how to take or inject your medications correctly.
- Advice from a nurse or pharmacist to help you prevent and manage medication side effects and injection site reactions.
- A nurse or pharmacist who knows you by name, listens to your medication concerns, and helps you take an active role in your health care.
- Someone to help you resolve issues, whether it be financial, practical, or clinical, that may get in the way of you taking your medication correctly.
- A pharmacy who works with your physician to ensure you are receiving the greatest possible benefits from your therapy.

How This Program Benefits You

Living with a chronic health condition and taking specialty medications can be challenging and expensive. Left untreated, worsening symptoms and severe side effects may lead to additional and often avoidable extra visits to your physician, urgent care or the emergency room. However, when well-managed, specialty medication may delay disease advancement. This can mean an improvement in your quality of life that may allow you to do the things you want to do — such as go to work, care for yourself and provide for your family.

This program is your first step to successful specialty medication therapy. Our nurses and pharmacists will monitor your progress and work directly with your physician to provide you education on your condition and medication, tools and advice, and access to support groups to help you stay on track. If you have problems or challenges in your therapy, Regional Home Health+ Specialty Pharmacy and your provider will team up and work with you to find the best solution.

Participants in this program will be automatically enrolled, and you are free to opt out at any time. Your success with your specialty medication depends largely on your ability and willingness to follow the prescribed course of therapy.

How To Enroll

Our Therapy Management Program is meant to provide added support and resources to patients who are taking specialty medications to treat chronic conditions such as hepatitis C, cancer, rheumatoid arthritis, psoriasis, psoriatic arthritis, Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis, multiple sclerosis, HIV/AIDS, solid organ transplant and osteoporosis. These services are available at no additional cost. If you are eligible for this program, our clinical staff will enroll you when you pick up or receive your medications and follow up with you through the course of your therapy.
