- + How to use this service:
 - Call the Sturgis Library at 347-2624 between 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. Monday - Friday or 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. on Saturday.
 - City staff will help you place your order. Items may include groceries, toiletries, cleaning supplies, and other household necessities. Books and audio-video resources from the Library can also be included.
 - A volunteer or staff member will fill your order (if items are available) at a local store and will

deliver the order free of charge to your residence. The participant will need to pay for the items with cash or check when the delivery is made. There is a \$50.00 limit on grocery orders, however, participants can order as many times during the week as needed.
