Our program offers help and support for people taking specialty medications. We help you understand your medications and why you are taking them. Our goal is to work with you to make sure that you get the most out of your specialty medications.

How we help

The only pharmacy of its kind in the region, Monument Health Home+ Specialty Pharmacy focuses on the medication needs and therapy management for patients with chronic, rare or complex conditions that require specialty medications. We offer services such as refill reminders and 24-hours-a-day, 7-days-a-week access to a pharmacist. By taking part in the Therapy Management Program, you also have access to a nurse or pharmacist who:

- Knows about your specialty medication therapy, including your needs and goals.
- Can help you learn how to take your medications.
- Provides advice to help you prevent and manage side effects and reactions.
- Knows your name and listens to your concerns.
- Helps you take an active role in your health care.
- Helps to sort out issues, whether they deal with taking your medicine or paying for it.
- Works with your doctor to make sure you get the best results.

What this program can do for you

It can be difficult and costly to live with a chronic health problem and take specialty medications. Without treatment your condition may worsen. Even with treatment, serious side effects may occur. This can lead to extra doctor visits, or trips to urgent care or the emergency room.

Specialty medication may slow the spread of disease. This may help you do the things you want to do, like working and taking of yourself and your family.

This program is your first step to successful specialty medication therapy. Our nurses and pharmacists will track your progress and work with your doctor to teach you about your condition and medicine. They will give you tools and advice and tell you about support groups to help you stay on track.

If you have problems with your therapy, Monument Health Home+ Specialty Pharmacy and your provider will work together to help you solve them.

Patients who need specialty medication therapy are automatically signed up for this program, but you can opt out at any time. Your success can depend on your willingness to follow the directions given to you by your doctors, nurses, and pharmacists.

What are your rights & responsibilities?

Our New Patient Information Booklet lists your rights and responsibilities as a patient. Please review this booklet and let us know if you have any questions.

How to take part

Our program provides support and resources to patients with chronic conditions who take specialty medications. This includes patients with hepatitis C, cancer, rheumatoid arthritis, psoriasis, psoriatic arthritis, Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis, multiple sclerosis, HIV/AIDS, solid organ transplant, osteoporosis and more. We will talk to you about the program during your initial counseling. We provide this program at no added cost. If you choose to not to take part in the program, please tell your pharmacist or nurse.
