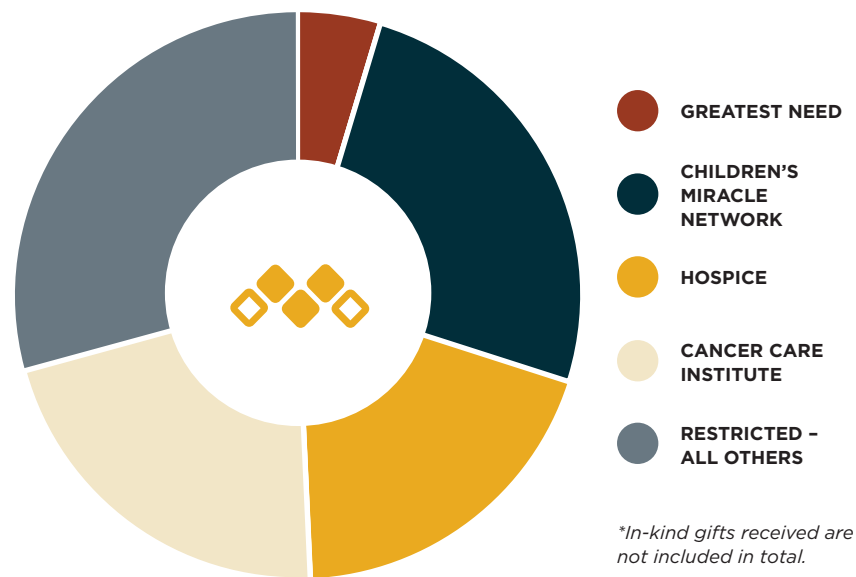
One example of this community spirit and involvement was in the purchase of the

A NEW FUND TO PROTECT OUR CAREGIVERS AND SUPPORT OUR PATIENTS

At the outset of the pandemic, when personal protective equipment was in short supply across the nation, the Monument Health Foundation created a new fund to support community efforts that would help keep our caregivers safe.

Monument Health Foundation's COVID-19 Medical Response Fund was used to purchase or help produce vital medical equipment that protects caregivers so they can continue to fight this virus.

The Monument Health Foundation used donations from the newly established fund to help with the

creation of hundreds of facemasks through local organizations across the Black Hills. Distributions from this fund were through requests by Monument Health's Supply Chain Management leaders to the Monument Health Foundation. Donations to the fund were also used to purchase iPads so our patients could stay connected with loved ones while in the hospital and create oasis rooms for our caregivers to have a calm and quiet place to relax.

Nearly \$50,000 was raised through this campaign thanks to your generous donations.



TOGETHER WITH PURPOSE

When COVID-19 began its spread across our region, the work at the Monument Health Foundation shifted focus to respond to the immediate needs of our patients and caregivers. We jumped into action to find new and creative ways to help patients and support our caregivers. Together, with our community, we found new solutions to the unprecedented challenges we faced. A CALM AND QUIET PLACE

Thanks to the work of Monument Health Foundation staff along with the newly created Physician and Caregiver Support Team, Monument Health caregivers and physicians in all markets now have dedicated spaces to help them unwind while at work.

Fourteen special oasis rooms have been set up in strategic locations throughout the system, and all caregivers and providers are welcome to use them.

Equipped with comfortable seating, calming white noise machines, aromatherapy and dim lighting, the rooms are optimized to give a restful experience for one or two caregivers at a time. The Monument Health Foundation helped purchase the equipment for the calming environments, and caregivers in each market helped design the rooms.

SAFE TRANSPORT FOR OUR YOUNGEST PATIENTS



Monument Health's Rapid City Hospital is able to safely transport infant COVID-19 patients thanks to a donation from the Monument Health Foundation that facilitated the purchase of a new piece of equipment.

The nearly \$20,000 donation from the Children's Miracle Network at the Monument Health Foundation allowed the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit to purchase a GE Healthcare Giraffe Shuttle.

The shuttle is a transportable power source that allows our caregivers to transfer possible COVID-19 positive infants from the delivery room to the NICU while in the safety of an enclosed warmer bed. This piece of equipment allows for access power, auxiliary equipment and medical gas during the transfer.

The ability to transfer our smallest patients this way improves outcomes for the patients and also improves caregiver safety.



A GRANT FOR LIFE-SAVING TECHNOLOGY

A generous grant from the Helmsley Charitable Trust to the Monument Health Foundation helped purchase equipment that could save the lives of COVID-19 patients and protect the frontline health care workers caring for them.

The \$196,164 grant will fund the purchase of 16 LUCAS mechanical chest compression devices for Monument Health.

“These devices are vital because we don’t want frontline healthcare workers to choose between trying to save a patient or risking exposure to themselves and others to the COVID-19,” said Walter Panzirer, a trustee for the

Helmsley Charitable Trust. “LUCAS has been a proven, effective tool in saving lives during cardiac arrest, and having more of them available during this pandemic will save even more lives, including those of doctors, nurses and other health care workers.”

The rise in cardiac complications caused by COVID-19 exposes both patients and health care workers to greater risk, as hands-on CPR can be needed for extended periods and personal protective equipment can become less effective in keeping the virus from spreading to medical providers.

WHY DOES CHILDREN'S MIRACLE NETWORK NEED SUPPORT?

- When you donate to Children's Miracle Network at Monument Health, you help ensure that every child in our community gets care, regardless of their family's ability to pay.
- By supporting Children's Miracle Network, we are able to continue to provide specialized care right here in our community so that families can have their support system of family and friends close by during challenging times.
- Since every single dollar you donate to Children's Miracle Network stays local, your efforts are helping children in your community. This might be a kid in your neighborhood or even a loved one whose life is impacted by these funds.
- There are many different kinds of technology in the NICU, including different types of infant ventilators, monitors, and supportive devices, such as infusion pumps and incubators. Every piece of equipment used in the NICU is purchased through community donations to Children's Miracle Network, giving kids a chance at life.
- When families have to travel for specialty medical care, Children's Miracle Network is there to help with travel assistance funds. Last year, CMN provided over 130 families with Pediatric Emergency Travel Funds totaling more than \$41,000.
- Rapid City Hospital will care for over 370 NICU babies in a year, and they need our help to make sure these babies get the best care they deserve.
- CMN supports all areas where kids are treated within our health care system, such as Labor & Delivery, Obstetrics, the NICU, Advanced Care Pediatrics and Pediatrics in all of the Monument Health communities.
- Supporting CMN means you're helping those families during the time spent in the NICU. Most preterm infants stay in the NICU until their due date. Thus, if a child was born six weeks early, parents can expect that their child will be in the NICU for six weeks. The NICU often becomes a second home for many families, where parents spend many hours each day with their infants. For the most part, these tiny infants must learn to breathe and grow before they can go home.

NICU PURCHASES



Thanks to your donations to Children's Miracle Network at the Monument Health Foundation, newborns, infants and children who are patients at Rapid City Hospital have access to the latest technology and greater comfort.

In the last year alone, the Foundation made more than \$300,000 in donations to acquire new medical equipment and patient comfort items that help assure children have the best possible experience during their time in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Newborn Nursery, Labor and Delivery, Pediatrics or Advanced Care Pediatrics.

Kamela Johnson, Director of Women's and Children's

Services at Rapid City Hospital, said the equipment purchased through CMN is literally a lifesaver for some of their most vulnerable patients. "These children face a lot of challenges, and it's gratifying that we can provide the best, most up-to-date technology as we care for them," she said.

Purchases range from \$15,500 for a Giraffe Open Warmer for Advanced Care Pediatrics patients, to \$125,700 to buy seven Panda Warmers with resuscitation modules, replacing old warmers in each of the birthing rooms. The list also includes a \$37,000 ultrasound system to help medical staff place intravenous lines in tiny NICU babies.



KIDS CAN'T WAIT

Children's hospitals like those at Monument Health are on the frontlines of the COVID-19 crisis, open 24/7/365 to provide high-quality, compassionate care that sick children and adults need. But we can't do it alone.

The ripple effects of COVID-19 will affect every aspect of the treatment and services offered by children's hospitals. Without philanthropy, many may face significant impacts in the short and long term.

We know we can address the most challenging health issues of today while preventing and preparing for those to come. When we fund children's hospitals, we transform how we meet the most urgent needs, saving more lives and protecting our collective future.

When we change kids' health, we change the future - for all of us.



CMN CHAMPION

By all appearances, Colin is your typical teenager. He runs cross country and track, plays piano in the jazz band and is his class vice president. He enjoys taking photos and videos of interesting weather and aspires to be a meteorologist. And, of course, he likes to hang out with friends.

What differentiates him from his peers is that Colin has autosomal recessive polycystic kidney disease (ARPKD), a rare inherited childhood condition where the development of the kidneys and liver is abnormal and leads to these organs slowly failing. Because of this disease, Colin has overcome many challenges that most kids never face. When he was born at 36 weeks, his chances for survival seemed very slim, and he spent two months in the NICU. For the most part since then, his life has been "pretty normal," with routine testing, but his family knew that one day he would need a kidney transplant.

In March 2019, his condition progressed enough that he was put on the list and has now been matched with a donor. The upcoming transplant won't be a "cure" - and he'll need immunosuppressant medicine for the rest of his life - but it will help treat his disease.

Colin's focus remains positive, and he tries not to let his ARPKD slow him down. He's a hard worker, participates in lots of activities and volunteers to help with just about anything. Colin continues to take each day as it comes and is determined not to let his disease define him.

SHANNON'S STORY



Shannon says it was faith, family, the power of positive thinking and the dedicated staff at the John T. Vucurevich Cancer Care Institute that helped her summon the strength to fight cancer.

In 2012, Shannon was a single mother to a five-year old boy and worked full time. Her life was busy, but she had plenty of blessings to be thankful for. She had started seeing a new boyfriend a couple of months prior, and things were going well. She was healthy and even training to run a half marathon.

But shortly after her 30th birthday, Shannon's life was turned upside down. She had started to notice a loss of energy and went to her doctor after experiencing severe

abdominal pain. Shortly thereafter, Shannon was diagnosed with cancer – stage-three adenocarcinoma in her colon.

After surgery at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota, she came back to the John T. Vucurevich Cancer Care Institute for her treatment with Dr. Mark Schroeder.

After 12 chemotherapy treatments, Shannon had nine months with no evidence of disease and things were looking up again. Her boyfriend proposed shortly after her last round of chemotherapy. The couple was married in October after a five-month engagement.

“He never wavered in all of this,” Shannon says of her

now husband. “It rocked all of our worlds when I was diagnosed and he didn’t run.”

But only two months into their marriage, the cancer came back. It was a lump in Shannon’s abdomen, and a biopsy revealed the same type of cancer as before was found in her abdominal wall. This time Shannon was slated for an even more aggressive surgery and chemotherapy treatment.

Throughout both of her battles with cancer, Shannon says she remained positive and didn’t let negative thoughts – like the chances of her survival – ever enter her mind.

“I didn’t want to hear them,” Shannon said. “I didn’t want to have those conversations, because the odds weren’t going to define me.”

She attributes the hard work, dedication and positivity of Dr. Schroeder and his team for helping beat those odds not once, but twice. In December, Shannon celebrated being free of cancer for the past five years.

But there was another set of odds Shannon and her husband also beat. Before her first round of chemotherapy, Shannon spoke to doctors about the possibility of having more children. They told her that to increase her chances she should have some of her embryos saved for the possibility of in vitro fertilization after she had beat cancer.

Just a few short months after her last chemotherapy treatment, Shannon was pregnant with a little girl and without the assistance of in vitro fertilization. The couple had another child two and a half years after that.

“They give me the strength to keep fighting,” Shannon said of her family.

Having gone through two arduous battles against cancer, Shannon now preaches the value of prevention. She said it’s important to have regular screenings like mammograms and colonoscopies.

Though she is healthy now, Shannon said, “You never want to walk in my shoes if you don’t have to.”
